UPDATE ON THE RESTORATION PROJECT IN JOHNSTOWNBRIDGE

Dear Friends

Many thanks for the support of our restoration project in Johnstownbridge. It is heartening that so many are keen to see this church renewed and refreshed.

The heritage officer from the County Council has visited recently and we can proceed with the necessary works as they fall under maintenance. The project will take a few years and we will need to proceed in stages.

As a first stage, we need to restore the two windows beside the Altar as both are in a serious state of disrepair. Also, the window in the sacristy is in need of restoration. We have been in contact with a number of heritage joiners and we hope to start work on these within the short term.

After this, and, at the earliest, probably next year, we would hope to paint the building externally and internally. We can proceed with this if we do not paint the ornate ceiling or the backdrop to the altar, except where damaged. While doing this, we will also consider how best to replace the floor covering and we will look at the lights and examine how best to replace them.

In the longer term, and over a longer period, we will need to examine the stained-glass windows and restore them as necessary. This is highly intricate work, and it demands special expertise but it would have to be performed over the longer term and in stages, as there are different levels of attention and restoration necessary.

In order to finance this, we have already gathered €6000-00 (2200 from the coffee morning and 3800 from the Jubilee collection). Stage 1, the restoration of the clear windows, will probably cost in the region of €10000. Over the next while we will try to have some fund-raising projects to make up the shortfall. Thanks, as always, for your support.

On the broader level, and thanks to your generosity, our finances stand in a relatively healthy position and we are meeting our day-to-day liabilities without incurring debt. Thanks to you all for this support! As always, if there are any questions about finance we would be glad to clarify any issues.

Otherwise enjoy this warmer weather and the quieter atmosphere of the summertime!
