## First Holy Communion and Confirmation for The Children of Cadamstown N.S

Fr. Sean is looking forward to the celebrations of First Communion (2.00pm) and Confirmation (3.30pm) on Saturday 11 May.

The Confirmation candidates will be welcome to attend Mass on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> of May at 10.00 in Broadford and to make confession afterwards. Parents are most welcome to attend also.

The celebrations will be outside in the park as heretofore. We would advise all candidates for Communion to register their presence at the gate from 1:30pm, where they will receive their designated space. No seating will be provided but people are free to bring camp seats if desired, particularly for older guests.

We would ask people to respect the nature of the sacrament with due decorum and silence while Communion is being distributed. The ceremony will be simple with an emphasis on the Eucharist and welcoming Christ into the lives of those making Communion for the first time.

There will be a brief period afterward, but we ask those who are not staying for Confirmation to make space in the parking area for the Confirmation candidates and their families by 3.00.

We will open registration for the Confirmation candidates at 3.10 and the ceremony will be in the context of a liturgy of God's Word. Again, we would recognize the importance of a respectful and prayerful atmosphere.

Candidates are invited to bring a card with the first name and the chosen confirmation name, in large print, on one side and then with their full name, their chosen confirmation name and the sponsor's name on the back. These will be kept by the confirming priest but, if desired, can be returned after registration.

We will examine the possibilities of making the pledge later. Obviously if the weather proves inclement, we will be forced to move the celebration indoors but hopefully we will be lucky enough to proceed as heretofore.
