First Holy Communion and Confirmation Cadamstown

Fr. Sean is looking forward to the celebrations of First Communion (11:00am) and Confirmation (12:15pm) on Saturday 10 May.

The celebrations will be outside in the park as heretofore. We would advise all candidates for Communion to register their presence at the gate from 10:30am, where they will receive their designated space. No seating will be provided but people are free to bring camp seats if desired, particularly for older guests.

We would ask people to respect the nature of the sacrament with due decorum and silence while Communion is being distributed. The ceremony will be simple with an emphasis on the Eucharist and welcoming Christ into the lives of those making Communion for the first time.

There will be a brief period afterward, but we ask those who are not staying for Confirmation to make space in the parking area for the Confirmation candidates and their families by 12:00 noon.

We will open registration for the Confirmation candidates at 12:00 noon and the ceremony will be in the context of a liturgy of God's Word. Again, we would recognize the importance of a respectful and prayerful atmosphere.

Candidates are invited to bring a card with the first name and the chosen confirmation name, in large print, on one side and then with their full name, their chosen confirmation name and the sponsor's name on the back. These will be kept by the confirming priest but, if desired, can be returned after registration.

Obviously if the weather proves inclement, we will be forced to move the celebration indoors but hopefully we will be lucky enough to proceed as heretofore.

On Friday evening the 9^{th of} May, we offer confession in Broadford Church from 6:00pm-7:15pm followed by Mass at 7:30pm. During Mass the candidates will be invited to make the pledge and a ceremony of light will take place. Please bring baptismal candle. This will be a simple prayerful event. All are welcome!
